
Downstairs includes open concept kitchen, living room, dining area and a full bath.

Important— Please read!

It is very important for Corps of Engineers compliance and for everyone's safety that no items of any kind be stored on the fingers of your slip. This includes any furniture, cabinetry, appliances, kayaks and other small watersports equipment. The fingers must be kept clear at all times. You may store certain items such as storage boxes or cabinetry on the back walks of your slip, however there must be a minimum of 4 feet clearance down the center of the walkway for safety. Fuel cans, paint and batteries must never be stored on your slip at any time. Thank you for your cooperation!
