January Fuel Dock Hours

The Marina Store and Fuel Dock will continue to remain open for pump outs, ice, supplies, snacks & drinks, logo merch and gifts during our fuel system renovation.

Fuel System Upgrade

The new fuel system is planned to be up and running by spring of 2022. Grandpappy Point Marina is the closest location with fuel. Remember that it is against our rules to use any portable gas can in your slip. If you need to use a gas can, you must be outside of the slip and outside of the marina.

Regarding Heaters

Electric heaters such as space heaters are prohibited while the boat or dock is unattended. If you leave your boat or dock for any period of time, any heaters must be unplugged. This rule is set by the NFPA 303 and will be enforced by Eisenhower Yacht Club. Certified bilge heaters designed for the sole purpose of heating on board a vessel may still be used.

January Housekeeping Reminders

Please keep supplies stored safely and neatly in your slip or docko. Supplies, materials, accessories, hoses, cords, rope or any debris may not be stored along the walkways or finger piers.

When your pets are in the marina they must be controlled for their safety as well as the safety of other tenants and visitors. Outside of your slip, your pet must be on a leash. Do not chain or tie your pets to the docks and remember to always clean up after them.

Laundry, towels and life jackets are not to be hung off of the docks, walkways or finger piers. Please store them in your boat, cabana or docko.
